- To be the globally adopted specification for efficient interoperable technical information for operations, maintenance and training that support the life cycle of the product

- Achieve optimum reuse and interoperability of technical information by providing an agile, efficient, data module-centric, platform-neutral specification, while maintaining consistent data structures, leveraging other standards, and helping meet applicable regulatory requirements



S1000D Steering Committee organization

- New SC participation categories (in addition to existing members) approved
 - Non-affiliated observer
 - Represents an industry or customer consortium not associated with one of the S1000D parent organizations
 - One seat on the SC (not participating in consensus discussions) and no WG/TT participation
 - Approved by the Council (MOU) - One year time limit
 - Non-affiliated participant
 - Represents an industry or customer consortium not associated with one of the S1000D parent organizations
 - One seat on the Steering Committee (not participating in consensus discussions) and full WG/TT participation
 - Approved by the Council (MOU)
 - Emeritus
 - Individual participation of a former representative (as of 2015-11-03) of a full member or non-affiliated participant
 - One seat on the Steering Committee (not participating in consensus discussions) and full WG/TT participation
 - Approved by the Council (IP agreement)
 - Invited expert
 - Individual participation upon invitation of the WG/TT chair
 - No SC/WG/TT membership
 - Approved by the Council (IP agreement)

- Published beginning of February 2017
- All “Pending Approval” CPFs are included
- To be delivered later:
 - BRDP Index

 - Data Dictionary

Next steps: Extant CPFs


- CPF database cleaned before restarting CPF review
 - “Pending Approval” → “Completed”
 - Some existing CPFs withdrawn based on feedback from nations and working groups
 - “Candidate” & “Inwork” → “New”
→ to be updated as required by the new Change Process
 - Owner of “New” CPFs changed to nation / working group focal point
- Total number of “New” CPFs in CPF viewer: 108
- Review by the SC has started on June, 7

Next steps: New S1000D Change process

- Principle
 - Full responsibility of nation/WG to deliver complete CPF material
→ CPF owner at New status is the nation/WG focal point
 - Sequential integration of CPFs into the S1000D
→ Chapter text, schemas and bike samples are consistent at any time
 - Publication of new public issues every two years
- CPF states
 - New / Inwork / Approved / Complete / Rejected / Withdrawn / Returned
 - “Candidate” status deleted → business case accepted by the SC when CPF has been accepted within nation/WG
- Status
 - Updated CPF White Paper template available
 - CPTT is finalizing the “S1000D Change Process Standard Operating Procedures”
 - New process used by the SC



Next steps: S1000D Modularization

- Modularization concepts defined
 - Foundation and Building Blocks
 - High-level table of content
 - Draft SNS and Information Codes for S1000D
- Prototypes developed
 - Building Block creation
 - SNS breakdown and ICs, conversion to XML and display in HTML
- Decision to modularize S1000D after Issue 4.2
- Modularization is defined as:
Restructuring of S1000D using principles of foundation and building blocks (in accordance with Council guidelines and SMTT proposal) to allow projects to more easily tailor the specification
- Modularization will include XMLization
- Status
 - Detailed project planning available
 - Document analysis (SNS, IC, level of breakdown, authoring schema, ...) ongoing
